- I apply for my child to become a member of Maidenhead Athletic Club.

- I understand that in the event of any injury or illness during a Club activity, all reasonable steps will be taken to contact me, and having parental responsibility for my child, I give permission for first aid to be administered or, where considered necessary, treatment by a suitable qualified medical practitioner.
- If I cannot be contacted and my child should require emergency hospital treatment, I authorise a qualified medical practitioner to provide emergency treatment or medication.
- I agree for my child to be photographed or videoed under the supervision of an adult coach, during a Club activity.
- I agree to support the Junior section of the Club in one of the following ways:
 - By assisting for at least 5 sessions during the membership year (a 50% reduction in session fee will apply to each of those sessions).
 - By being a team manager for 2 indoor or 2 outdoor competitions during the membership year.
 - By becoming a qualified coach and joining the coaching rota.
 - By becoming a qualified official and being part of the Clubs officiating team at competitions.
 - By becoming a qualified Child Welfare Officer and assisting with Saturday morning registration.

Please note that club officers and coaches are unpaid. Subscriptions pay for the costs for running the club, funding entry into competitions, hall hire for the winter (indoor) season and where possible buying new equipment.
